**FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION**

Applications are invited online only by 'One Time Registration' from qualified candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes Converted to Christianity (SCCC) community of Kerala State for selection to the under mentioned post. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. **Candidates who have AADHAR CARD should add AADHAR Card as ID. Proof in their Profile.**

- 1 Name of firm : Kerala Municipal Common Service/ Various Development Authorities.**
- 2 Name of Post : Driver Gr II (LDV)**
- 3 Scale of Pay : ₹18000-41500/-**
- 4 Number of vacancy : Scheduled Castes Converted to Christianity (SCCC) – 1 NCA Vacancy**

Note 1. The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to the above community but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked list published on 11.10.2019 for the post (Gazette Date: 30.08.2016 Category Number: 225/16).

2. Kerala Public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidates to the above post of Kerala Municipal Common Service, if it is subsequently found that such advise was made under some mistake. On such cancellation the Appointing Authority shall terminate the service of candidate, provided that, the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the Appointing Authority shall be made within the period of his/ her probation or 240 days from the date of his /her joining duty whichever is earlier.

- 5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to SCCC Only).**  
Note:- Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than the above will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

- 6. Age Limit : 18-39. Only candidates born between 02.01.1982 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (including Para 2(i) of the General conditions.)**  
(For other conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions).

Note The provisional hands working in the above concern will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of five years from the upper age limit provided they are

within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the above concern and also provided they possess a minimum service of one year in the provisional appointment. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It should also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern. The over aged candidates who become eligible to be included in the Ranked List on the basis of their provisional service in any Company/Corporation/Board/Authority/Society will be considered only in the vacancies reported by the same concern, in which they have worked provisionally.

Note:- Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the certificate as given above and vague statements such as vision normal etc will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. Special attention should be directed to the distant vision. Required standard of vision are as follows.

	<i>Right Eye</i>	<i>Left Eye</i>
(a) Distant Vision	6/6 Snellen	6/6 Snellen
(b) Near Vision	0.5 Snellen	0.5 Snellen

(c) Each eye must have full field of vision.

- Note
- 1 Differently Abled persons are not eligible to apply for this post.
  - 2 Candidates should possess Current Driving Licence and Badge on the last date for receipt of applications in this office and also on the date of OMR test, practical test, interview and at all stages of selection.
  - 3 The proficiency in driving will be assessed by conducting a practical test.
  - 4 Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.
  - 5 In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC Book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette Notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer /Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
  - 6 Appropriate disciplinary/ penal actions as per Rule 22 of KPSC Rules of Procedure, will be initiated against those candidates who give confirmation for writing the examination by providing false claims about their qualifications/ experience irrespective of whether they have attended or abstained from the examination.

## 8 Mode of submitting applications

Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission [www.keralapsc.gov.in](http://www.keralapsc.gov.in) before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2011. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed

legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application.** The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
